





2018 Union Dues

The delegates to the 39th IBEW International Convention held in 2016 authorized a Per Capita increase to be paid to the International Office. Accordingly, all dues payments covering Jan. through Dec. of 2018 are \$112.50 per quarter.

Dues are to be paid at least quarterly in advance. You can pay ahead either:

1 Quarter (3 Months) = \$ 112.50

1/2 Year (6 Months) = \$ 225.00

3/4 Year (9 Months) = \$ 337.50

Full Year (12 Months) = \$ 450.00

Pay Your 2nd Quarter (April, May, June) dues now to avoid a \$30 reinstatement fee.

A \$30.00 reinstatement fee will be charged if payment is received later than the end of each guarter.
